 induce more independence to the decision making of the Chairman of
 NWCL and he will be able to look into the matters of the Investment
 Committee overall.
- Amendments to the Terms of Reference
 Any amendments to the Terms of Reference shall be proposed by the
 Investment Committee and those amendments must be approved by the
 Board of Trustees and not the Board of Directors of NWCL.

Re-starting of Mahapola Trade Fair & Mahapola Lottery

Hon. Mr. Malik Samarawickrema, Minister of Development Strategies and International Trade stated that the Board had to re-think on the above. He enquired whether the the MTF is capable of starting a Lottery of its own.

The Hon. Minister enquired as to who was going to run the Lottery.

Mr. D.C. Dissanayake, Secretary, Ministry of University Higher Education & Highways stated that the MTF should discuss with the Development Lotteries Board and then decide.

Hon. Mr. Malik Samarawickrema, Minister of Development Strategies and International Trade stated that he will speak to the Ministry of Finance and report at the next Board Meeting.

RECORDING OF NON-FINANCIAL ASSETS OF MTF AS PER THE FINANCE CIRCULAR 1/2017 ISSUED BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE AND MASS MEDIA

Mr. M.P. Bandara, Director MTF tabled Board Paper No.3 on the above subject.

Mr. M.P. Bandara, Director MTF informed the Board that he had a discussion with the Comptroller General of the Ministry of Finance and Mass Media on the above matter on 25th September 2017 and informed that MTF is not a Government undertaking, and therefore it is not required to report its non-financial assets as per the above circular.

Mr. Bandara tabled for the information of the Board a copy of the letter forwarded to the Mr. P.B.S.C. Nonis, Comptroller General of the Ministry of Finance and Mass Media in this regard.

Dr. Wickrema Weerasooria at this stage pointed out that the letter dated 23rd June 2003 issued by the Attorney General's Department is an important document since it clearly states that the Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund is an independent body corporate not subject to any governmental regulations.

Dr. Wickrema Weerasooria referring to the Company's letter to the Comptroller General, Ministry of Finance and Mass Media requested Mr. S. Hettiarachchi, Secretary Ministry of Education to check and report on the following

- Whether SLIIT is an asset or a lease income
- Whether the Development Lottery Board (DLB) is an Associate Company of MTF having 50% ownership

7. BOARD PAPER NO. 4

ESTABLISHMENT OF INVESTMENT COMMITTEE OF NWC

Mr. M.P. Bandara, Director, MTF tabled Board Paper No.4 in connection with the above.

The Board having noted the recommendation of the Management Committee approved the establishment of Operational Guidelines and TOR of the Investment Committee of NWC.

8. BOARD PAPER NO. 5

SUSPENSION OF MONTHLY SCHOLARSHIP INSTALLMENTS OF THE MEDICAL STUDENTS ENGAGED FOR THE STUDENTS BOYCOTTING THE LECTURES FOR THE PERIOD 2017/02 TO 2017/11

Mr. M.P. Bandara, Director MTF tabled Board Paper No.5 in connection with the above.

The Board was informed that as per the Mahapola Scholarship Payment policy and guidelines students not attending lectures regularly or not following the academic activities, will not be paid the scholarship instalments for that period.

Mr. Bandara stated that Medical Students of 08 Medical Faculties were engaged in the strike from 2017/02 to 2017/11 (almost 9 months). According to the above payment policy MTF has taken action to suspend the payment of the 9 instalments from the students of the Medical Faculties of all academic years.

The Board noted that the Management Committee of MTF had recommended to get a decision of the UGC for the above suspension. The Board in the meantime was informed that the Deans of all 08 Medical Faculties of the Universities have requested to release the installments due for strike period as the academic activities of the strike period has already been extended.

The Board having noted the letter received from the Deans of the Medical Faculties approved the release of the 9 scholarship instalments which were suspended from the total instalments due for the academic period, to the Medical Students of all Medical Faculties.

9. BOARD PAPER NO. 6 DISPOSAL OF MOTOR VEHICLE OF MTF

Mr. M.P. Bandara, Director MTF tabled Board Paper No.6 in connection with the above.

The Board noted that the valuation obtained for the motor car from Sri Lanka Automobile Association was Rs.3.9 Mn and the highest offer obtained was from Mr. W.K.R. Wijewardena, who offered Rs. 3,457,750/-.

The Board approved the disposal of the Motor Car, Toyota Yaris (Registration No.WP KU 2082) to Mr. W.K.R. Wijewardena at Rs.3,457,750/- being the highest offer.
